

NURS FPX 4020 - Improving Patient Safety in Medication Administration

Identifying the Problem

Identifying the main cause of an event in the hospital is essential for improving patient safety. This will help nurses avoid similar events in the future and reduce the adverse consequences of those errors. Moreover, it will improve the quality of care that patients receive in the hospital. This will also increase the staff's morale and boost productivity levels.

Nursing is an important profession. It requires a great deal of skill and knowledge. In addition, nurses need to be able to think critically and communicate clearly. This is why it is so important to develop your attention to detail skills. To develop your attention to detail, try to focus on one thing at a time. This will prevent you from getting distracted and losing your train of thought. Identifying the Stakeholders

Identifying stakeholders is essential to understanding who is involved in the process of quality improvement. These individuals can include patients, caregivers, administrators, physicians, and other healthcare professionals. Stakeholders also play an important role in defining and measuring healthcare quality and safety targets. In addition, they can assist in shaping identity and motivating community members to engage in quality and safety initiatives (Paul et al., 2022).

Developing a Plan of Action

You will prepare an online tool kit or repository of resources to help your audience understand the research behind a particular safety improvement plan pertaining to medication administration and put

the plan into action. You will also cite a minimum of three sources of scholarly or professional literature and use the Writing Center resources to get feedback on your [NURS FPX 4030 Assessment 1 Locating Credible Databases and Research](#) writing.

Implementing the Plan

Having attention to detail is essential for working in the healthcare field. This skill is crucial for nurses because medication mistakes can put patients at risk. In addition, these errors can lead to other serious health problems. Nurses must follow the guidelines for proper medication administration, including checking patient histories, assessing allergies, verifying prescriptions with EHRs, and carefully calculating dosages.

Nurses also need to communicate with patients and other health care professionals effectively. This includes ensuring that the communication protocol is clear and concise and that all stakeholders are included. The communication system should also allow nurses to report error messages and receive feedback.

Attention to detail is a valuable skill for nursing students, especially those who work full time and are taking online classes. This can help them stay organized and not miss important assignments or due dates. Moreover, it can also help them maintain a positive learning environment.
